

# Figurenotes with Ukulele

There are two ways to use Figurenotes on ukulele:

- ① Tune the A string to a G, and the E string to a C, so you end up with **G C C G**. This allows you to barre the chord and it won't matter if it is major or minor. Use stickers on the neck to show where to play.

Using this method allows time to get used to the strumming patterns and rhythmic playing, without having to concentrate on tricky fingerings. Great for confidence and coordination, this way of playing uses smaller steps rather than having to do everything in one go. It helps beginners make music together very quickly.



- ② Keep the standard tuning of **G C E A** and teach the chords using the coloured boxes and a photo of the ukulele chord from the player's perspective. This makes the chords easier to play, learn, recognise, and memorise.
